COURSE DURATION

The course will last one academic year, **from October 2023 to June 2024**, according to the timetable to be established by the EAEM management.

REGISTRATION

Online applications accepted until June 9th, 2023 through the eaem.es website.

Course fee for the Advanced Course in Orchestral Technique is **704 euros**, which includes accident and instrument insurance. EAEM students are enrolled as full members of the University of Santiago de Compostela.

UNIVERSITY POSTGRADUATE: The Advanced Course in Orchestral Technique is a fully-accredited course of the University of Santiago de Compostela, compromising a total of **ECTS 60 credits (1,500 hours).**

GRANTS

All students will have a stipend of **300 euros per month**, from October 2023 to June 2024, both included. They will also have the possibility of accommodation at the **Burgo das Nacións University Residence** (180 metres from the School).

COURSE CONTENT

Students will participate in a minimum of six programmes with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra of Galicia. They will receive private lessons of instrumental specialisation, chamber music, music theory and master classes of different specialities given by prestigious lecturers invited for the occasion.
